



123rd ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION & CONTEST

Dear Instructors,

We are very excited to announce that the American Guild of Music is holding its National Convention and Contest at the Marriott Columbus Airport Hotel **July 11-14, 2024**. We will again hold a contest that is shortened by a day so it will be a Friday- Sunday contest to help make it affordable. Be prepared for Thursday evening competition if needed. Contest registration will open May 16th.

Please read the 2024 Rules and Regulations as there have been a few changes. All areas of change appear in bold, italicized print. **WE WILL USE THE 2023-2026 Online SYLLABUS FOR THE NATIONAL CONTEST. You can obtain copies of all AGM Contest forms on line at www.americanguild.org/blr.html.**

An enrollment fee will apply to all students and will include a program, badge and t-shirt. The enrollment fee will vary depending on whether your entry is entered online or mailed in. **Thus, when entering your students, you must specify the t-shirt size for each student.**

Remember to include email addresses for each student or their parent. Please note that the teachers email address must not be listed as the students email address. This is will particularly important to have during the contest, as we will be able to send live updates regarding room changes and event schedules as they are happening in real time.

We ask that you pay close attention to our time deadlines throughout this year's contest entry process. Please make note that we will only field phone calls from teachers or studio personnel. ***Please inform all parents and students that under no circumstances will we field any phone calls from parents or students regarding changes to the schedule! We will ignore these calls because*** we simply do not have the personnel to handle phone calls from parents/students. One more reminder: when calling about corrections or changes, ***please call the provided number only. It is important for teachers to follow all deadlines and double check all confirmations and schedules. Late information slows down the process for everyone.***

NATIONAL CONTEST INFORMATION

Awards Banquet

Awards at the Nationals are given at the Grande Awards Banquet on Sunday evening. Performing at the Grand Awards Banquet are the Convention Orchestra, Choir and the North American Invitational Championship winners. All students who attend the nationals are expected to attend the annual awards banquet. Tickets must be ordered in advance from an email to be announced at a later date.

All Around Awards

These awards are exclusive to the National Contest and everyone who participates is automatically entered if the instrument on which they are playing has a minimum of 20 students or is 10% of the contest. Points are kept for placing 1st thru 6th in all divisions and points are awarded for participation in activities such as the Essay Contest, Theory Test and Sight Reading. Huge trophies are given out at the end of the Awards banquet.

Convention Choir & Orchestra

These activities are open to all students who attend the contest. The choir is open to students of all ages without a portable instrument, and vocal students. The Choir and Orchestra is geared towards the more advanced students and teachers are invited to participate. They perform at the awards banquet on Saturday. Both the choir & orchestra meet for nightly rehearsals. A \$12.00 registration fee is required for each. (All-Around Points given)

Cadet Teachers Course

This four year course is for students 14 or older and introduces students to some basic principles of private music instruction. Students discuss handling situations that may arise in everyday teaching. No specific instrument is addressed. A \$20.00 registration fee is required. Please indicate which year 1st, 2nd or 3rd. (All-Around Points given. Students under 14 can obtain points by composing an essay entitled "What the AGM National Contest Means to me")

North American Invitational Championship (NAIC)

This is our most prestigious division and takes place on the final day of the contest. Instruments eligible are Accordion, Guitar, Drum Set, Snare Drum, Keyboard, Sequenced Keyboard, Pop Piano, Classical Piano, Violin, Vocal Musical Theater, Vocal Pop and Vocal Classical.

To qualify for this division you must place 1st or 2nd in a qualifying round which takes place at AGM Regionals. A final NAIC qualifying round is held on the first day of the National Contest. Since this is an Invitational Contest we invite other music competition to send their winner of their top division to our contest. To qualify from another contest other than an AGM contest the contestant must have a letter from the organization on official letterhead, which must be submitted to the Contest Director for approval. (No All- Around Points given)

Age Finals

To qualify you must place 1st through 5th in any Age Achievement division throughout the previous contest year which runs August through July. Trophies given for championship only. (No All-Around Points given) (Cash Award Given)

Items To Remember:

- *We will use 2023 -2026 Syllabus for the Test List that is available on line.**
- *All Entries that are mailed must be received by JUNE 10, 2024** (late entries will not be accepted without a late payment fee of \$20.00 PER STUDENT and the permission of the Contest Director)
- *Please remember to list the name of the Test List song for each student included on the mail-in enrollment form.**
- * Entries entered on line must be paid for by paypal. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PAID BY June 12 2024. Unpaid entries will not be scheduled and will be subject to late fees.**

Enrollment fee & Facilities Fee

All students must pay the enrollment fee of \$37.00 per student mail-in registration or \$30.00 per student for online registration and will receive a program, badge and Tshirt of the size indicated. **Please remember to indicate your students t-shirt size and keep a record of it.** The t-shirt size portion of the registration process does not always work. It would help to send your recorded t-shirt list to schedule@americanguild.org.

A facilities fee is charged per family and those families who stay 2 nights or more will get it refunded to them. If two children from the same family are entered into the contest we must manually adjust the fee so that it is charged one time.

On-Line Registration Entry

Online Registration is available for AGM Members only. If you are an AGM Member you should have received via email a login code and password for past contests. The same password is valid. If you have not, please email a request to agm@americanguild.org. Members can reset their passwords when logging in. Online Registration is fast and efficient since information for all students who have entered past contests will be all ready in the database and there will be no need to retype this information. Confirmations will be immediately emailed upon submission.

Mailed or Emailed Entries

Please send us an email with all students information, DOB, LOS, Instrument, the solo categories, t-shirt size and the parents email and we will enter it manually for the mailed in enrollment fee. You can mail in a check to 2877 Alpine terrace, Cincinnati, Ohio 45208 by June 12th.

Group and Duet Enrollment Forms

The Group Enrollment Form is used for all groups, bands, ensembles, pop combos and battle of the bands. This form ties in with the group section on your accounting forms. The entry form includes a box to mark as well as a space to write the group number. You provide the group number. The same is true for duets – mark the box and provide us with a duet number. These numbers that you provide us for groups and duets help us assign the correct players to each group and duet. **REMEMBER THAT IF YOU ARE ENTERING GROUPS – YOU MUST EMAIL IN THE GROUP FORM.**

Contest Grants

We would like to see all students participate in the Great Lakes Regional Contest. We have a limited number of grants that are available for students of member teachers. The Student must submit an essay titled “Why I want to attend the National Contest” and the teacher must send a letter describing why the student deserves a grant. Take advantage of the grants by sending in your essay before June 15, 2024 to agm@americanguild.org.

Scheduling Change Policy.

Please note that it is the teachers’ responsibility to check all entries for accuracy. Once a schedule has been released a teacher has the opportunity to submit changes up to 72 hours before the start of the contest. No changes will take place 72 hours before the contest or at the contest. All changes must be accompanied by a \$10 change fee.
